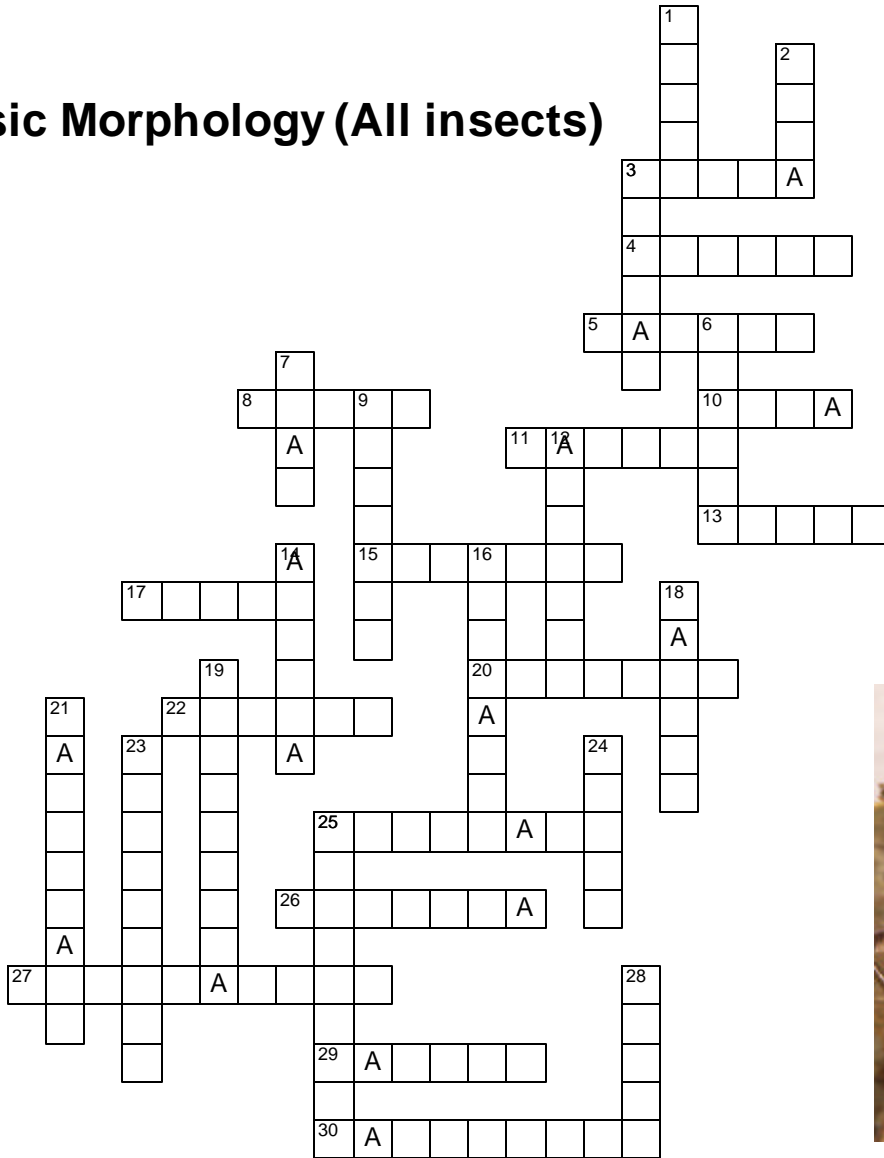

## Basic Morphology (All insects)



### Across

- 3. Next to last segment of leg
- 4. "Eyes" on top of head in some Heteroptera
- 5. Hind wing in Diptera
- 8. Segmented appendages at tip of abdomen in Mantodea and Blattaria
- 10. Side of face, "cheek"
- 11. Lower lip
- 13. Wing indentation on anterior margin in Odonata
- 15. Hardened forewing in Coleoptera
- 17. Leg segment three in most insects
- 20. Modified cerci in Dermaptera
- 22. Top of head
- 25. Newly emerged Ephemeroptera
- 26. Collembola
- 27. Second segment of leg in many insects
- 29. Upper lip
- 30. Chewing mouthparts

### Down

- 1. Structures found on abdominal sternites of Microcoryphia
- 2. Leg segment attached to body
- 3. Body region containing wings when they are present
- 6. Leathery forewings of Orthoptera
- 7. Most anterior of 3 body regions of insects
- 9. Sclerite above upper lip
- 12. Posterior body region of insects
- 14. Antennal structure in higher Diptera
- 16. Vibrating membrane used in sound detection
- 18. Distal segments of leg
- 19. Forewings in Heteroptera
- 21. Dorsal pair of palpi
- 23. Sucking mouthpart
- 24. Front of head
- 25. Triangular sclerite fitting between junction of wings in Heteroptera and Coleoptera
- 28. Flight structures
