



## Florida Eastern Equine Encephalitis Surveillance January 1 - August 22, 2009

- Confirmed Captive Bird EEEV (Total = 1)
- ▲ Confirmed Sentinel Chicken EEEV (Total =143)
- Counties under mosquito-borne illness advisory

St. Johns, Volusia, Walton, Columbia, Leon, Suwannee, Clay, Madison, and Union counties are currently under mosquito-borne illness advisories. Eastern Equine Encephalitis virus (EEEV) positive horses were identified in Volusia (9), Columbia (6), Clay (5), Madison (4), Union (4), Leon (3), Bradford (3), Duval (3), Suwannee (2), St. Johns (2), Washington (2), Holmes (2), Gilchrist (2), Alachua, Flagler, Lake, Levy (2), Clay, Hamilton, Osceola, Marion, Walton (2), Baker, Nassau (2), Putnam, Okaloosa, and Jackson counties. A positive cassowary was identified in Nassau County. There were 143 seroconversions to EEEV in sentinel chickens from Walton (49), Orange (25), Leon (9), Pasco (2), Gulf (7), Nassau (10), St. Johns (24), Putnam (6), Flagler (6), Bay, Sarasota, Volusia (2), and Alachua counties.
