[**Illinois—Du PAGE Co.:** Hinsdale, 7 June 1986, Monte Lloyd, received 1 *septendecim* male and 11 *cassini* males from presumed stragglers of Brood XIII in Ann Arbor on June 10, disturbance squawks sounded normal, none sang calling songs while caged in Ann Arbor.]
